1. BACKGROUND

1.1 "Bengal Gas Company Limited" (BENGAL GAS) a Joint Venture between GAIL (India) Limited, A Maharatna Government of India Undertaking (CPSU) and Greater Calcutta Gas Supply Company Limited (GCGSCL) (A Government of West Bengal Enterprise) has been authorized by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) to lay, build, operate and expand City Gas Distribution (CGD) Network in the Geographical Area comprising of "Kolkata Municipal Corporation and parts of adjoining districts of North 24 Parganas, South 24 Parganas, Howrah, Hooghly and Nadia" to cater natural gas supply to customers in the domestic, transport, and commercial sectors, approximately spreading over 1529 Sq Kms in 40 Municipality areas. The map of Kolkata Geographical Area (GA) is attached as Annexure-I for reference.

1.2 Keeping in mind the necessity of CNG infrastructure expansion and to achieve the assigned targets, Bengal Gas has been setting up CNG Stations on various business models. For business expansion, huge CNG station infrastructure is being rolled out in different locations in Kolkata Geographical Areas (GA) of Bengal Gas. Further, several developments are taking place in LNG/LCNG based Transportation Sector wherein CGD companies are developing LNG/LCNG stations in non-pipeline areas

1.3 One such model of CNG Station is Dealer Owned Dealer Operated (DODO) model.

1.4 In this regard, BENGAL GAS invites offer through Expression of Interest (EOI) from Individuals/ Entrepreneurs / Sole Proprietorships / Partnerships / Limited Liability Partnerships / Companies/ Cooperative Societies / Joint Ventures/ / Government organizations/bodies, PSUs (herein after called BIDDER), for 'Selection of Dealer For Setting Up CNG Station on Dealer Owned Dealer Operated (DODO) Model' at specific stretches/Locations in Kolkata Geographical Area (i.e., Bengal Gas operational Area) which includes Kolkata district and parts of Howrah, Hooghly, Nadia, North-24 Parganas and South-24 Parganas.

1.5 The purpose of inviting this EOI is to encourage the BIDDER to set up CNG Station and further utilize the existing potential of Natural Gas in Automobile sector.

- 1.7 BENGAL GAS reserves the right to withdraw or amend or withheld the EOI based on government directives / their business requirement/ for any other reasons.

2. INTRODUCTION

- 2.1 CNG is the compressed form of Natural Gas, which is mainly composed of methane [CH₄].
- 2.2 CNG is being successfully used as fuel in our transport system, more popularly termed as "Green Fuel". For use in Automobiles as fuel, it is compressed to a pressure of 200-250 bar to enhance the vehicle on-board storage capacity. CNG or Compressed Natural Gas is a fossil fuel substitute for petrol, diesel, or LPG. It is an environmentally cleaner alternative to other fuels and is much safer too in the event of a spill.
- 2.3 With the gradual increase in demand and supply of Natural Gas, there has been a surge in CNG Vehicles.
- 2.4 A CNG station is a facility where vehicles can refuel CNG. These stations compress natural gas to a high pressure for storage and dispensing into vehicles.
- 2.5 The Bidder shall submit the EOI for DODO model CNG Station for their respective stretches of road/location, as mentioned in Annexure-I (Kolkata GA Map) & Annexure-VIII (List of Road Stretches /location for DODO CNG Station)
- 2.6 In this model, Dealer will be the land owner or have a long-term lease agreement with the land owner to set up the CNG station at the selected location.
- 2.7 The total investment, including land and civil work, except CNG equipment, shall be made by the dealer. The control of the CNG stations in terms of operation and forecourt management shall rest with the dealer. Various audits, including safety audits and technical audits, will be conducted by Bengal Gas or its authorized representatives or any statutory body. The Station design, Canopy, Signage shall be as per the specification of Bengal Gas.
- 2.8 The installation and subsequent maintenance of CNG equipment shall be done by Bengal Gas.
- 2.9 Applicants can offer land in their own name or hold jointly with the family members, submitting No Objection Certificate/Power of Attorney from such joint land owners, or applicants having leasehold land from any Government or Semi-Government authority.

- 2.10 In addition, applicants may offer land arranged on a long-term lease basis from third party landowners for a minimum period of **10 years**.
- 2.11 In case the land belongs to Government/Semi-Government authority and is leased to Applicant for specified period, the Applicant can offer land on Sub-Lease to Bengal Gas. In such cases, suitable Legal Agreement will be signed with the Applicant along with No objection certificate from Government / Semi-Government authority. In case of Sub-Lease, period of Sub-Lease shall be equal to or less than the lease period between Applicant and landowner. Validity of such lease should not be less than **10 Years**.
- 2.12 Land is to be taken by Bengal Gas on registered lease for a minimum applicable of **10 years with a provision to extend every 5 years** thereafter and Bengal Gas to pay a **Fixed Nominal Lease Rent (Rs 24,000/- per year)** from the date of registration of lease agreement. Cost of registration of lease agreement to be borne equally by Bengal Gas and Dealer.
- 2.13 Dealer will be paid **Dealership Commission (DC) on Rs. /Kg basis** for CNG sold from the station.
- 2.14 In case of Daughter Booster Station (DBS), the transportation of compressed gas from Mother Station to DBS will be in the scope of Bengal Gas including arrangement of Transportation & related equipment. Online Station may be considered by Bengal Gas in case the required length of steel pipeline (from the main pipeline network till the proposed retail outlet site) is approx. from 1 to 1.5 KM and laying of such pipeline is found feasible. However, in case of higher business potential, future expansion and facility, it may be extended by the approval of competent authority.
- 2.15 After the Selection of BIDDERS and subsequent LOI Issue and Acceptance, a Dealer Agreement shall be executed between Bengal Gas and Dealer, wherein the Dealership Commission (DC) along with other terms and conditions shall be clearly defined.
- 2.16 The Dealership Commission to be offered to the Dealer shall be intimated to the Dealer by Bengal Gas prior to the signing of the Dealer Agreement.

3. SUBMISSION OF EOI

- 3.1. EOI should be filled, signed, stamped and submitted in Hard copy to HOD (CA&CO), BENGAL GAS COMPANY LIMITED, 1st Floor, Block-A, Finance Centre, CBD, Action Area-II, Newtown, Kolkata-700161, India and the Soft copy through e-mail at Email ID: hodcaco@bgcl.co.in before due date and time.
- 3.2. A non-refundable application fee of Rs.6000/- in the form of Demand Draft in the name of 'Bengal Gas Company Limited' in lieu of dealership consideration shall also be submitted along with the EOI. Failure to submit will result in rejection of the bid.

3.4. The Documents to be attached include filled, signed & stamped Annexure-II, Annexure-III & Annexure-IV along with Annexure-V & Annexure-VI (if applicable).

4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The following applicants who have their own land plots in their names/ having agreement to lease or lease agreement for not less than 10 years along with NoC of land owner (in case of leased land offered by the applicant) for making application for CNG Dealership & setting up CNG Station on the Land are eligible to apply.

- 4.1. The BIDDER should be of a minimum of 21 years of age (in case of individual BIDDER).
- 4.2. The BIDDER shall be of Indian nationality AND having land either through ownership/ rent / consent to use for the purpose of setting up of either DODO Model CNG Station in Kolkata Geographical Area, i.e., Kolkata District OR parts of its neighboring districts of Howrah, Hooghly, Nadia, North-24 Parganas and South-24 Parganas.
- 4.3. Government organizations/bodies, PSUs, companies registered under Companies Act 1956, Private/Public Limited Companies, Registered Co-Op. /Consumer Societies, Partnership firms and Joint Ventures (JV).
- 4.4. In case of Partnerships, all Partners to individually fulfill the Eligibility Criteria as specified above.
- 4.5. In case of Registered Co-Operatives/ Consumer Societies, there should be at least One person (nominated by the board) fulfilling above Eligibility Criteria.
- 4.6. In case of Joint Ventures (JV), there should be at least One person from each Party, nominated by the board/authorized by partners fulfilling above Eligibility Criteria.
- 4.7. In case of Firms/ Companies/ Organized Bodies, there should be at least One person (nominated/authorized by the board/partners) of the firms/ organized bodies, fulfilling above Eligibility Criteria.
- 4.8. Brokers/Property dealers are not eligible

5. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- 5.1. The plot should be open with clear & undisputed title.
- 5.2. Frontage of plot should be abutting the national highway/state highway/major district roads/other district roads.
- 5.3. Land size should be approximately 800 sq. meters, with a frontage of about 25 meters and depth of about 32 meters for daughter station and 1200 sq. meters plot size with a frontage of about 30 meters and depth of about 40 meters for online Mother station.
- 5.4. The plot size indicated above shall be measured after leaving applicable ROW as per

norms of NHAI/PWD/State Highway Departments/Local Authorities etc.

- 5.5. In case of land situated on national highway, the bidder will ensure that the land offered meets the **latest NHAI guidelines** contained in **Govt. of India, Ministry of Road, Transport & Highways**. The offered land should also meet norms of statutory bodies like forest, explosives etc. and the land should be convertible for commercial and CNG Station use.
- 5.6. The bidder shall arrange all statutory clearances such as urban land ceiling, non-agriculture conversion, Income Tax Clearance, Non-encumbrance etc. and no Objection certificate from co-owners, if any.
- 5.7. If the entire land does not belong to the bidder, then the group of people who have plots contiguous to each other meeting our requirement can quote through one of them holding Power of Attorney for the others.
- 5.8. Bidders offering agricultural land shall convert the same to non-agricultural purposes, more particularly for the use of CNG stations or other allied purposes at their own expense and cost. The land must be suitable for development for CNG station and other commercial activities and impact charges, if any, need to be paid to the local development authorities right now or in future also, the same shall be paid by the land owner/applicant & the same shall never be recoverable from Bengal Gas.
- 5.9. Regarding Financial capability, the Bidder having Minimum net-worth of Rs.80 Lakhs as on 31st March 2025 will be eligible, in case of Individual Bidder. (Bank Solvency Certificate as proof must be submitted).
- 5.10. Net Worth shall be computed as: Paid up share capital plus Free Reserves & Surplus less accumulated losses, deferred expenditure and miscellaneous expenditure not written off, if any
- 5.11. In case of Firms, only the Firms making a Net Profit (PAT) for the previous Three (03) consecutive financial years as certified by a Chartered Accountant (with a valid UAN number) will be eligible.

6. DISQUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The following land owners are not eligible,

- Applicants convicted or against whom charges have been framed by a Court of Law for any criminal offence involving moral turpitude/ economic offence (other than freedom struggle).
- Mentally unsound person/ totally paralyzed person.
- Signatory to an agreement of a RO/ SKO-LDO Dealership/ LPG distributorship of any oil company terminated on the grounds of adulteration/ malpractice.
- Guilty of willfully giving wrong information.

7. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE

BIDDER to submit the supporting documentary evidence in support of the documents

submitted

- 7.1. Age/Name Proof (AADHAAR Card, Election ID, Passport, Birth Certificate, etc.)
- 7.2. Residential Proof (AADHAAR Card, Election ID, Passport, etc.)
- 7.3. Partnership deed, in case of partnership firm with ID proofs of each partner.
- 7.4. In case of Firm, Certificate of Incorporation or issuance of any other Government license/certificate must be submitted. In case of sole proprietorship or any other case where certificate of incorporation is not available, GST registration or issuance of any other Government license will be considered. In case of absence of any of the above documents, PAN card of the sole proprietor along with declaration of establishment of the proprietorship will be considered.
- 7.5. PAN Card and GST Certificate must be submitted.
- 7.6. Proof of business experience, showing area of work & duration and achievements /appreciation, if any (Work Order, Completion Certificate, any other valid Certificates)
- 7.7. Key plan showing details of property
- 7.8. Ownership documents (Registered Title deed showing the ownership of the land)
- 7.9. Registered Lease deed (in case of lease hold lands)
- 7.10. Copy of Revenue Department documents such as Mutation Certificate, Conversion Certificate, Khasra, Khatian, Parcha, Kajhna, etc.
- 7.11. Copy of Power of Attorney (for Power of Attorney Holders)
- 7.12. Latest Property tax receipt.
- 7.13. Title clearance certificate and non-encumbrance certificate from a Govt. Pleader or from an Advocate panelized in any Nationalized bank.
- 7.14. NOC from landlord in case of lease hold land.
- 7.15. Bank Solvency Certificate in case of Individual and Net-worth Statement showing Net Profit (PAT) for the previous Three (03) consecutive financial years as certified by a Chartered Accountant in case of Firms shall be submitted. (UAN No. of CA must be submitted).
- 7.16. The name of the BIDDER should exactly match the name as per certificate of incorporation and / or any other applicable documents and Annexure-III, i.e., BIDDER Information Form.

8. EVALUATION OF THE EOI

- 8.1. Evaluation of the EOI shall be done in two stages, i.e., Preliminary Evaluation, which is based on the EOI documents submitted by the BIDDER and Evaluation, which is based on Physical visit and Evaluation of the plot by the Working Level committee and Interaction with the Selection committee.
- 8.2. During Evaluation, all documents submitted by the BIDDER shall be considered authentic and evaluation shall be conducted based on the documents submitted in Hard copy and soft copy to the specified e-mails & no further investigation or physical examination of the claims made by the BIDDER shall be carried out.

- 8.3. BIDDER shall be shortlisted based on the Eligibility criteria and Qualification criteria fulfilled.
- 8.4. Working Level Committee (WLC) shall then evaluate the plot.
- 8.5. Subsequently, the BIDDER (Authorized Signatory in case of Firms) shall be invited for Interaction with Selection Committee.
- 8.6. The total marks obtained based on the evaluation shall be noted in Merit List as per descending of total marks. Merit list of BIDDERS shall be displayed on the Bengal Gas website.
- 8.7. The Merit List shall be valid for two years from the date of website publication. A maximum of two dealers will be selected for each stretch. Bidders who qualify but are not in the top two ranks will be ranked according to the evaluation criteria. If a dealership offered to the first or second-ranked candidate is withdrawn or terminated within the Merit List's validity, Bengal Gas reserves the right to award the Dealership to the next highest-ranked candidate after necessary re-evaluation of eligibility criteria.

9. ISSUE OF LOI & SIGNING OF DEALER AGREEMENT

- 9.1. If at any point in time it is found that any of the information furnished in the documents submitted is not authentic/genuine, the application shall be rejected immediately. If LOI has been issued, Bengal Gas reserves the right to cancel the same.
- 9.2. Applicants shall be shortlisted based on the Evaluation, i.e., Eligibility and qualification criteria fulfilled. Subsequently, the Final list of Selected Bidders shall be displayed on the Bengal Gas website.
- 9.3. A maximum of 2 no. of Dealers shall be selected for each stretch based on existing/proposed CNG Infrastructure in that stretch. (Ref. Annexure-VIII- List of Road Stretches /location for DODO CNG Station).
- 9.4. LOI shall then be issued to the qualified Bidders. The selected Bidders will be referred to as Dealers.
- 9.5. The Bidder must submit LOI Acceptance within 1 (One) month of the date of issuance of LOI.
- 9.6. After receipt of acceptance of LOI, BGCL shall share Agreement format.
- 9.7. Prior to signing of agreement, interest free refundable security deposit in the form of **Rs 5 lakh** (Rupees Lakhs Only) is to be deposited to the account of Bengal Gas through net banking/Demand Draft for the CNG Equipment to be provided by Bengal Gas.
- 9.8. The Dealer Agreement must be signed within 3 (Three) months of the date of issuance of LOI.
- 9.9. The Lease agreement shall be completed within 1 (One) month of the signing of the Dealer agreement.

10. SECURITY DEPOSIT

- Prior to commencement of operation, the Dealer must submit an interest free refundable security deposit of Rs.15 Lacs (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) in the form of Bank

Guarantee in the name of 'Bengal Gas Company Limited' from Nationalized bank for Natural Gas to be supplied by Bengal Gas to the Dealer for sale.

- If any statement made in the application or in the document enclosed herewith by the candidate at any stage is found to be incorrect or false and/or the applicant conceals any information, which if, would have made him/her ineligible for dealership, the application is liable to be rejected and in case the applicant has been appointed as a dealer, the dealership is liable to be terminated. In such cases the candidate / dealer shall have no claim whatsoever against company. The security deposit submitted by the dealer would be forfeited in such cases. The site shall continue to remain with company.
- Breach in Contract as per the terms of Dealership agreement shall also result in forfeiture of the Security deposit.

11. SCOPE OF WORK

11.1. Dealer's Scope of Work

- The Dealer must ensure that commercial operations are started within **9 (Nine) months** of signing the Dealer Agreement. Failure to comply shall result in termination of CNG dealership agreement after serving due notice.
- Change in Land Use (CLU): Dealer shall get the CLU of the land plot at his/her own cost well before the project activities commence at the plot.
- The total investment, including land, except CNG equipment, shall be made by the dealer. The control of the CNG stations in terms of operation and forecourt management shall rest with the dealer. The Station design, Canopy, Signage shall be as per the specification of Bengal Gas.
- The BIDDER shall follow all the statutory norms as prescribed from time to time by Government of India or local government/government bodies for setting-up of CNG Stations.
- Operations of the equipment: Day-to-day operations of the equipment and the CNG retail outlet including but not limited to operation of equipment (compressors, Dispensers, Gas generators, Electrical equipment, Cascades, etc.), Dispensing of gas to vehicles and general maintenance/ up keeping of CNG outlet as per standards of Bengal Gas.
- Permissions/ approvals: All necessary permissions required from all statutory authorities (like Chief Controller of Explosives (CCOE/PESO), local Municipal office, Local Administration, NHAI etc. for setting up of CNG stations. Payments of (property tax/ local towards authority, Municipal etc.) tax are also under dealer scope.
- Construction & other Utilities: All civil works such as foundations, canopies, electrical rooms, trenches, driveway, boundary wall, Sales room, signage, pylon (totem), entry / exit signs, hoardings, lightings Hi-Mast, Monolith/RVI, Air inflators, CCTV Cameras, etc. The technical details & design will be provided by Bengal Gas.
- Power: Power connection up to the site. All necessary permissions including deposits, cable charges, connection charges etc. as levied by the Power license for obtaining power supply, transformers and other associated electrical equipment, as required, shall be by

Dealer. Power cost towards illumination of the station including Power backup in case of electricity failure including procurement. and installation of Generator for power backup is in the scope of Dealer.

- Supply & maintenance of Fire Fighting equipment shall be Dealer's scope.
- Manpower: All manpower required for smooth operation of equipment installed at the station and dispensing of CNG to vehicles including security of station, housekeeping, Air inflator, etc. shall be arranged by the Dealer at their own cost. Uniform, shoes, etc. required as per Bengal Gas standards shall be in dealer's scope. Dealer would indemnify Bengal Gas against all charges, claims/dues etc. arising out of disputes relating to dues and employment of personnel deployed by him.
- Miscellaneous activities such as Housekeeping & horticulture expenses, telephone charges, Sales promotion etc.
- Ensure the safe operation of equipment and station.
- The Dealer shall take necessary Insurance policies covering risks associated with storage, transportation & dispensation of gas. The Insurance policies should cover not only product insurance but also loss to equipment & accessories and also public liabilities.
- Dealer to comply with all the Quality-of-Service Regulations, Technical & Safety Regulations of PNGRB

11.2. Bengal Gas's Scope of Work

- Gas Supply: Bengal Gas shall supply the gas to the CNG station through pipelines or through mobile cascades.
- Installation of Equipment: Bengal Gas will provide the design of the CNG station including building, canopy, signage, pylon (totem), etc. and the dealer shall abide by the same as per the technical design finalized. All the CNG equipment like compressors, dispensers and cascades will be installed and commissioned by Bengal Gas. All Fire & Safety related equipment required as per statutory rules/ guidelines for safety of CNG Equipment. Topographical Survey and Soil testing is part of design of station and shall be under Bengal Gas scope.
- Maintenance: All periodic and break down maintenance of CNG equipment will be in the scope of Bengal Gas.
- Power: The cost of power towards running the compressor will be reimbursed by Bengal Gas. A separate meter will be installed for this purpose.
- Training: Bengal Gas will train the technicians / manpower hired / deployed by the dealer for dispensing and Fire Fighting.
- Safety and Technical audit: Bengal Gas would carry out the Safety and technical audit as per schedule and also as and when required.
- Any operational gas loss beyond reasonable Industry norms and as being historically noted by Bengal Gas in the subject GA to be borne by the Dealer.

11.3. A Brief matrix of scope of work for DODO model is provided in Annexure-VII for

reference.

12. BUSINESS MODEL

The following model of business will be followed,

- Bengal Gas will sell a particular quantity of Compressed Natural Gas to the Dealer on a daily basis.
- The Dealer shall sell Compressed Natural Gas to the End Consumers, i.e., CNG Vehicle owners on the Fixed Selling price, decided by Bengal Gas.
- The mode of payment receiving shall be either through Cash or online modes such UPI/Debit or Credit Card belonging to Bengal Gas.
- The offline cash collected shall be duly deposited in Bengal Gas' account on the next day after adjusting to the Dealership Commission (DC) of that day. If the same cannot be done due to any unavoidable circumstances, proper justification will be required. A fortnightly reconciliation statement with details of measurement, cash & online deposit and adjustment of DC will be duly certified by both Dealer and Bengal Gas and final transaction, if any required, will be made within 2 days of end of fortnight for that fortnight.
